

Colossians 30 - Unbearable - Study

Sometimes people are unbearable

- How and when are people (unbearable) vexing towards you?
- How do you handle these moments?
 - How do you respond and react?

Unbearable with God

Romans 3: 9-23

- How are we unbearable with God?
 - By rejecting Him, not fearing Him, lack respect, disobedience, love other things more than Him?

Psalm 36

- How does God show His mercy, compassion and patience with us?

Big Idea: The Son of God bears others with love, because his Father has infinite patience with him

Colossians 3: 12-13 (a)

- How can I imitate God and endure unbearable people?

Application: Enduring unbearable people, because God puts up with us

Non-Christian: Invitation to receive this undeserved treatment of God

- Has He had patience with you
 - Has He put up with you
 - He wants to put up with you a lot more
- Want to extend love and forgiveness
 - Adopt you
 - Choose you
- Surrender to Jesus and decide to follow Him
 - to repent and be baptized
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior

Christian: Putting up with Others
