Devoted by His grace

- 1 Corinthians 15:9-10
 - What does Paul know about the grace of God?

- What does the grace of God have to do with our surrender to the Kingdom?

Strong by His grace

- 2 Corinthians 12:6-10
 - How does the grace of God gives us strength?

Application: Living with the fullness of God's grace

Non-Christian: Receive

- Receive God's favor
 - It's free
- We have to accept it
 - By becoming a child of God
 - Decide to follow Him
 - Surrender to Him
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior
 - Repent and be baptized
- In this moment
 - We receive God's favor
- Don't wait

Christian: Living with the grace you have received

- Do you live with a lot of condemnation?
 - "There is no condemnation for me"
- Do you have trouble giving up your sins, God's work and working with Jesus?
 - May His grace be the reason you surrender.
- Who do you not give grace to?
 - Do you give them what they deserve
 - How can you give the same grace you have received from God?
