Non-Christian: Receive it

- Today you are traveling alone
 - You don't have the Spirit of God with you
- But you can have it
 - Today
- When making the decision
 - Surrender to Jesus and decide and decide to follow Him
 - By repentance and baptism
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior

Christian: Ask for more

Regularly, ask that by His Spirit, Jesus does His work in us

- Jesus, I beg you to:
 - Give me the power to do the things you do
 - Give me the courage to talk about you
 - Give me the words when I talk to this person
 - Guide me, teach me what to do
 - Take away this sin from me
 - Give me the ability to do the task that you have asked me to do
 - Let me feel love, peace, self control, joy and kindness
