Non-Christian: Become God's child

- You do it by making the decision to follow Jesus
- By surrendering to Jesus and decide to follow Him
 - By repentance and getting baptized
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and savior
- God will be your Father

Christian: Be a spiritual father or mother

 - Pray to the Father for them
 - Spend time with them
 - Study with them
 - Guide them to give their live to the kingdom
