- Psalms 34:1-3

- Apocalypse 5:13-14

 - Apocalypse 15:2-4

God sings over us

- Zephaniah 3:17

Application: Forget about yourself, and sing to God

Non-Christian: Worship God by surrendering to Him

Christian: Always sing

 - On Sundays

- Just start
 - Doing it
 - Sing with recordings
 - Sing alone
