- Philippians 2:14-15
- Why do complaints abound at work?
 - O How do we take glory from God when we complain?
 - How can we transform our complaints so that God receives glory from us?

Give glory to God by being missionaries in our jobs

- Matthew 28:18-20
- What does it mean to be missionaries at our jobs?
 - o How can we fulfill this great mission while we work?

Application: That our relationship with Christ transforms how we work

- To be children of God
 - Transformed on how we work
- We have a new Lord
 - We work for Christ

Non-Christian: An invitation

- If you have not never made the decision to surrender to Jesus
 - Decide to follow Him
 - To repent and be baptized
- Talk about this relationship
 - About being a child of God
 - About having God as your Father
- Is an invitation
 - o To enter in this relationship with God
- By surrendering to Jesus and decide to follow Him
 - To repent and be baptized
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior
