When we pray we fight the spiritual warfare

- Ephisians 6:10-20
 - O What is the spiritual warfare we are in?
 - What does prayer have to do with our spiritual battle?
 - What effect does it have in our spiritual battle when we pray?

We communicate with our Father when we pray

- Luke 11:1-13
 - What are the different kinds of things we should to say to God when we pray?
 - How does prayer connects us with our Father?

God works when we pray

- James 5:13-20
 - What does God do when we pray?
 - O What have you seen God do?

Application: What is your next step?

Non-Christian: Become a child of God

- Everyone can talk to God
 - But not everyone can talk with God

- As a Father and child
- Only those who are His children
 - o Those who have surrendered to Him
- If you have never made this decision
 - To surrender to Jesus
 - See the prayer
 - God's children talking with their Father
 - This should inspire you to surrender to Him
- This is an invitation to surrender to Jesus and decide to follow Him
 - To repent and get baptized
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior
- Everything you would be able to say to God
 - Is the greatest and significant
 - And is what will change your eternity

Christian: How can you talk more with your Father?

- Incorporate it daily
- Increase it as you speak
- Be more persistent
