Application: Always seek to speak the Gospel

Non-Christian: Accept the Gospel

 - Decide to surrender to Jesus
 - Repent and get baptized
- You have heard it today
 - Why don't you allow God to save you?
 - Surrender to Jesus today
 - and decide to follow Him
 - Repent and get baptized
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior
- What is stopping you?
 - o I invite you, beg you and implore you
 - o To do it

Christian: Always ask to do a study
