Genesis 22:1-19

Love and idols

- God wants us to love Him more than anything
 - We replace Him with idols

Isaiah 44

- What does this text say about idolatry?

- What do they make us do?
 - What is the problem of having idols?
- How has your life been impacted by your idols?
 - How have you turned your heart away from God?
- How do we protect ourselves from idols?

#1) Know what yours is

What's yours?

- What would you be asked to take to the mountain?
- That thing, person, experience
 - That fights for your heart
 - What do you love the most
- What is so important to you

#2) Love God more

- Is not so much to try to love your idols less
 - Is to love God more

The biggest way to do this is:

Non-Christian: Surrender to Him

- Love God by surrendering to Him
 - Surrender to Jesus and decide to follow Him
 - By repentance and baptism
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior
- That way you will put Him in the center of your heart
 - o And He will put His Holy Spirit in you

What is stopping you from making this decision to surrender to Him?

 - Being with Him
- Conversations
 - Read
 - Pray
- Thoughts
 - Meditate
 - Fast
 - o Praise
- Obedience
