Application: Accept God's calling

Non-Christian: Accept the call to get close to God

- If you are not a christian yet
 - o Probably is for the same reason
 - You have seen a lot of religiosity in religion
 - It repulse you
 - It drifts you away
 - God calls you to something even greater
 - And authentic
 - To be His beloved and forgiven son
 - To live your life close to Him
- Is what you receive when you surrender to Jesus
 - o And decide to follow Him
 - Through repentance and baptism
 - Accepting Him as your Lord and Savior

Christian: Accept the calling to live with the purpose of your Lord

- Jesús purpose
 - The purpose of Samuel
- He calls us to accept that this is our purpose
 - o Instead of being saved, good and normal, and go to church
 - o To live close to God
 - To guide others to get close to God
 - Accept that it is for this
 - that our Father saved us
 - and has us in this world
- How do we accept His calling?
 - Read the Bible and talk to God every day
 - o Have a person from the inside and from the outside that you are guiding
- What do you need to start doing, or do more of?
 - To be dedicated to your purpose as a child of God
