 - o In the life of blessings

Christian: Continue in the path that God has put you on

- Obey and continue faithfully
- What are the things that God has asked you to do?
 - What are the projects that God has giving you to do?
 - Who are the people God has put in your life?
 - So that you Guide them to Him
 - Do a List
- In your life, where and in what are you taking the shortcut?
 - Repent and come back to the path to God
- In what are of your life is it hard for you to wait and obey God?
 - Follow faithfully like Jesus
 - o Believe more in your Father than in how things look or how impossible it may be.
